

The following minutes were taken at the regular meeting of the Mayor and the Board of Aldermen at 6pm on June 4, 2024, at the Town Hall in Abita Springs, Louisiana. Mayor Curtis called the meeting to order.

MAYOR'S ANNOUNCEMENTS: Mayor Curtis announced that the Level -Burvant Street Rehabilitation Project is scheduled to begin on June 24<sup>th</sup>. The next agenda item was covered by Town Clerk, Janet Dufrene. Ms. Dufrene reported on details related to the "Safe Streets 4 All" plan, including the schedule of significant events. Next, Mayor Curtis noted that the Arrow Wood Interconnection clearing is underway, and the project is moving forward. The Mayor also mentioned that the Wastewater Treatment Facility Replacement Pre-bid Construction Meeting would take place on June 5 at the Town Hall and invited all interested parties to attend. Other points addressed by the Mayor included that the Leonard St. area would be the focus of upcoming drainage improvements and that staff would be conducting a hurricane preparedness training for Public Works Department Personnel.

**ROLL CALL:** Council Members Boudreaux, Contois, Saussy, Patterson and Templet were present. Mr. Saussy moved to accept the May 7, 2024, meeting minutes, seconded by Ms. Contois. All were in favor.

**OLD BUSINESS:** There was no "Old Business" discussed.

**NEW BUSINESS:** An opportunity for application to FHWA Recreational Trails Program for Louisiana was presented to the Board. Aldermen asked questions regarding the match, proposed sites, and the timeline. Board Members directed staff to move forward with drafting a resolution of support for the project.

**OPEN/ADJOURNMENT:** Resident Stewart Eastman brought up the subject of installing solar panels. area farms. Resident Nancy Bernard brought up possible safety concerns at the park around the gravel circle.

Mr. Saussy moved to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Mr. Patterson. All were in favor.
